Discussion Points

Update of Progress from the Working Group

- At the Joint Initiative Working Group (JIWG) Meeting following the last Joint Initiative Governance Group (JIGG) the Ministry produced an A3 diagram for discussion and feedback which showed the work the JIWG have done to date, where the group will be focussing its efforts and where the group is heading. The Working party is also in the process of developing a table which details the big ideas around principles and conditions, leadership and structures and resourcing necessary for successful collaboration and transition that the group has summarised from what it has seen/learnt/heard. It was agreed a column linking these elements to the evidence and field examples/illustrative quotes would be useful.
- The JIGG members present at the meeting reviewed the structure of the WP progress report and felt that it was a good framework. It was noted that we need to ensure that the Terms of Reference are reflected in the Joint Initiative working party scope and final report.
- At the JIWG scheduled for Friday 17th the working group will be finalising the "big ideas".

Next Steps

- The Working Group is enthusiastic to keep ECE/SE in the conversation but acknowledges that because of timeframes the priority focus is on primary at this stage. SM suggested we work on a clearly defined process to get us to the next phase i.e. a flowchart. **Action: 8/04:01 SM/SB.**
- Roles and Resourcing subgroup this is underway however there is some concern around meeting the 29th May deadline, as this is not negotiable. There was a suggestion that the Career
